**Information to Parents and Guardians Regarding Potential Job Action
by the Nova Scotia Teachers Union (NSTU)**

This morning, the Nova Scotia Teachers Union (NSTU) announced its plan to begin a work-to-rule job action on Monday, December 5, 2016, at all schools in Nova Scotia.

The NSTU has indicated that during a work-to-rule, teachers will continue to carry out their instructional duties in classrooms, but will not support any extracurricular activities including concerts, coaching teams or supervising clubs, and field trips will not go ahead. The NSTU has also indicated that teachers will arrive 20 minutes before school and leave 20 minutes after, as stipulated in the Teachers Provincial Agreement.

More details about the impact of a work-to-rule job action on schools and students will be made available in the coming days.
