AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT

POLICY STATEMENT

The Strait Regional School Board believes that each individual has the right to be educated and to work in a clean, safe and healthy environment. The Board therefore undertakes to document and address all complaints relating to building air quality quickly and effectively.

The Board endorses in principle the draft guidelines and procedures for air quality management published by the Nova Scotia School Boards Association in December of 1996.

GUIDELINES

1. Interpretation and application of the administrative responsibilities and procedures described in the NSSBA draft policy shall reflect the organizational structure, roles, responsibilities and workplace practices that are established in Strait Regional School Board policies and administrative procedures from time to time.
